Build your own Homeschool Planner with this huge collection of templates: everything you'll need to track learning and keep your busy homeschool family organised!

The following files are in a zipped folder and need to be extracted before opening:

- **Beverley's Checklists from The Educating Parent website**
 - expanded subject heading; natural learning checklist; bucket list planning tool; competencies and abilities checklist; art & craft suggestions; writing conventions; forms of writing; skills checklists
- **plus the Always Learning subject planning pages**
 - 2 styles to choose from
 - where you can list your child's interests, strengths and challenges and record a general overview of your approach to learning for each of the subject areas, the learning environment, and what you aim to pursue over the year, including extracurricular activities, learning goals, etc. If you are planning for more than one child, print a copy of these pages for each child.
- **variety of Diary pages**
 - 6 different diary pages to choose from, including Beverley's popular natural learning diary pages
 - print double-sided if you can, as many as you need (40 if you're working in school terms)
 - print enough for each child, or use one page for all children
 - supplement with photos (of your children's work, activities, excursions, etc)
- **selection of different lesson & unit study or project based learning outlines**
 - science investigation plan; excursion planner; excursion record sheet; unit study subject planner; topic planner; topic/theme monthly planner; project based learning template
- **assorted student self assessment**
 - my week; my plans for next year; my favourite...; all about me; my year (subjects); '3 things' evaluation page; reflections on this year; my reading log; my SMART goal; tracking my goals
 - attractively designed for children to use with support from you, help them develop the habit of reflecting and evaluating their own learning and being involved in planning their activities, can be counted towards English, Health, etc outcomes
- **weekly and monthly pages for scheduling activities, excursions, etc**
 - excursion and appointment calendar pages; 10 week subject planning templates; weekly check-in & planning meeting template; topic/theme month plan; excursion record; selection of weekly timetables (& example)
 - great for forward planning and/or retrospective recording and helpful memory jogger for reporting everything you've done over the year past. If you are creating a family planner, you will only need one set of calendar pages.

This is a digital download you may use for your personal use. Download and print as many pages and build your DIY planner in a way that suits your family. You can comb or wire bind your planner, or hole punch it and keep it in a ring binder, allowing you to add pages as you go. You could also add plastic pockets to hold work samples, art work, achievement certificates, souvenir brochures, etc. Please note: this bundle does not include Australian Curriculum content descriptions and achievement standards.
